


OUR PURPOSE to COMIT






WATER MANAGEMENT

Water initiatives like usage of irrigated from water provided by the on-site sewage treatment plant to water the gardens and the installation of water flow aerators are cost saving measures. Minimizing the water consumption without compromising guest comfort or health and safety are one of the major goals of Meeru.

Water management has been a key area of concern for us and we have been adjusting the flow rates, while calibrating the equipment for optimum water usage.



ENERGY CONSUMPTION

Energy efficient equipment, training staff to minimize energy consumption, controlled and monitored automated outdoor timer systems and recycling of waste energy are some of the implemented ways the resort conserve energy.

Reducing energy consumption assists in the reduction of the resort's environmental impact and at the same time lowers energy costs.

CELEBRATING EARTH DAY

In Meeru we join in the appreciation towards our Earth, together with the global community and all our in house guests. Lights around the island, in guest and staff areas will be turned off for one hour. Lighting of candles at the beach symbolized the support to save energy. We believe together we can make a difference and we love being connected with the world in this 60 minutes of appreciation!





Supporting our commitment to protect the marvelous marine environment around Meeru and in the Maldives, Meeru is 100% committed to the "No" to single use plastic campaig. Meeru strives to reduce plastic water bottles through offering water in glass bottles which is reused and refilled in the water desalination plant.

The savings for the environment are not only the reduction in single use plastic bottles, but also include the omission of transportation of the bottles from Malé to the resort.

Meeru's sustainability program policy follows the implementation of the "5 R's" concept to minimize waste.


The "5 R's" consist of the following steps and should be applied in the respective order:

PARLEY FOR THE OCEANS

A partnership we are particularly proud of is that with Maldives' branch of Parley for the Oceans that advocate avoiding the use of single -use plastics and encouraging responsible disposal of plastic that would otherwise end up in the ocean. Whenever possible, we follow Parley's guidelines of avoiding, intercepting, and redesigning the standards of plastic pollution. Recyclable waste as well as any plastic debris washed onto our beaches is regularly collected by Parley to ensure that it is treated as environmentally responsible as possible.





REGULAR BEACH AND ISLAND CLEAN UPS

Meeru's team and guests, join millions of others across the globe for the annual Clean Up in the World event. The Euro Divers team, together with members from the Marine Centre and guests participate in a house reef snorkel and scuba dive clean up on a local house reef. Whereas Clean Up the World is a big event, and part of a global campaign, we put a lot of emphasis on the environment in our day-to-day operation. Regular island clean ups are scheduled throughout the year.

We are working in collaboration with Ecolab , Green Path Maldives and Ian Greaves International (IGI UK), with the purpose of protecting our guests and employees.

LOCAL PURCHASING

Meeru purchase fish from local fishermen, locally grown fruits and vegetables, and follow hiring of services and equipment from neighboring islands and practice engaging in various activities and programs which support the local community.

As part of the sustainability of the local community, Meeru employs over 60% Maldivians. Most of the team members are from islands across the Maldives. Arts and craft made locally from team members and products in the Maldives are sold in Meeru Gift Shop. In addition, to showcase the rich culture of the Maldives various artifacts are displayed at the Meeru Museum which is accessible to all guests during their stay.

VEGETABLE & HERB GARDEN

The vegetable and fruit garden in Meeru encloses developed cultivated areas where both fruits and vegetables are being planted and grown. It provides the kitchens with an abundant supply of fresh fruits and vegetables every day. Over 20 different varieties are grown on site, from sweet potatoes to watermelons to chilies and zucchini. This ensures that all the restaurants offer healthy, nutritious and fresh produce, without having to import such ingredients and helping to minimize our impact on the environment.

This garden also features a plant nursery for orchids and seeds to enhance our gardens and island landscaping. Our Chefs and gardeners visit the farm regularly to ensure that quality and production are up to standard.

We invite our guests to join our Nature and Vegetation Exploration tour to understand how we manage to grow fruits and vegetables on a remote island in the Indian Ocean and how this vegetation helps preserve and respect our surroundings.

As a part of promoting the Meeru Garden, there was also a feature during the World Food Day celebration in Meeru.







CORAL NURSERY

The coral nursery at Meeru Island Resort and Spa began in 2016 after a coral bleaching event which affected most of the coral reefs in the Maldives. In order to help speed up the recovery of the reefs, fragments of coral are places onto frames where they can grow before being placed back on the reef.

Meeru Island Resort and Spa's coral nursery is one of the most successful in the Maldives and as such, the lagoon where the nursery is located boasts in a wide variety of fish species.

Coral reef nurseries are important in the continued battle against coral bleaching due to water temperatures rising.





EURO DIVERS MALDIVES

Euro Divers has ocean conservation at its heart and adheres to all PADI and Project Aware guidelines on the protection of the environment. They present and take part in the world wide AWARE campaign where they have programs scheduled to educate and bring awareness to guests in ocean conservation and protection.

Choose between the PADI AWARE Specialist, Dive Against Debris, Shark Conservation, Coral Reef Conservation, Fish ID and Peak Performance Buoyancy – they all go a long way in helping to increase awareness of the fragile marine environment.

NATURE WALKS

The "Nature Walk" is additionally an activity in Meeru that is conducted every Sunday and/or any day depending on the demand from the in-house guests. It is a guided tour conducted by Sports, Entertainment and Activities department. Guests are given a tour around the island and receive information about the history of various trees and plants.

This tour emphasizes on the importance of the trees that surround us and outlines the importance and benefits of maintaining these trees and plants.






CORAL PLANTING



LOCAL EDUCATIONAL TRIPS


